INFORMATION BULLETIN

1. **NO WAKE** along the EUREKA MAINLAND from the SAMOA BRIDGE, along WOODLEY ISLAND MARINA to the WESTERN MOST EXTENSION of the EUREKA PUBLIC MARINA.

2. Speed limit of the bay is **5 M.P.H. WITHIN 200' OF ANY DOCK-PIER-MARINA** to which boats are tied or is being used for the loading or unloading of passengers.

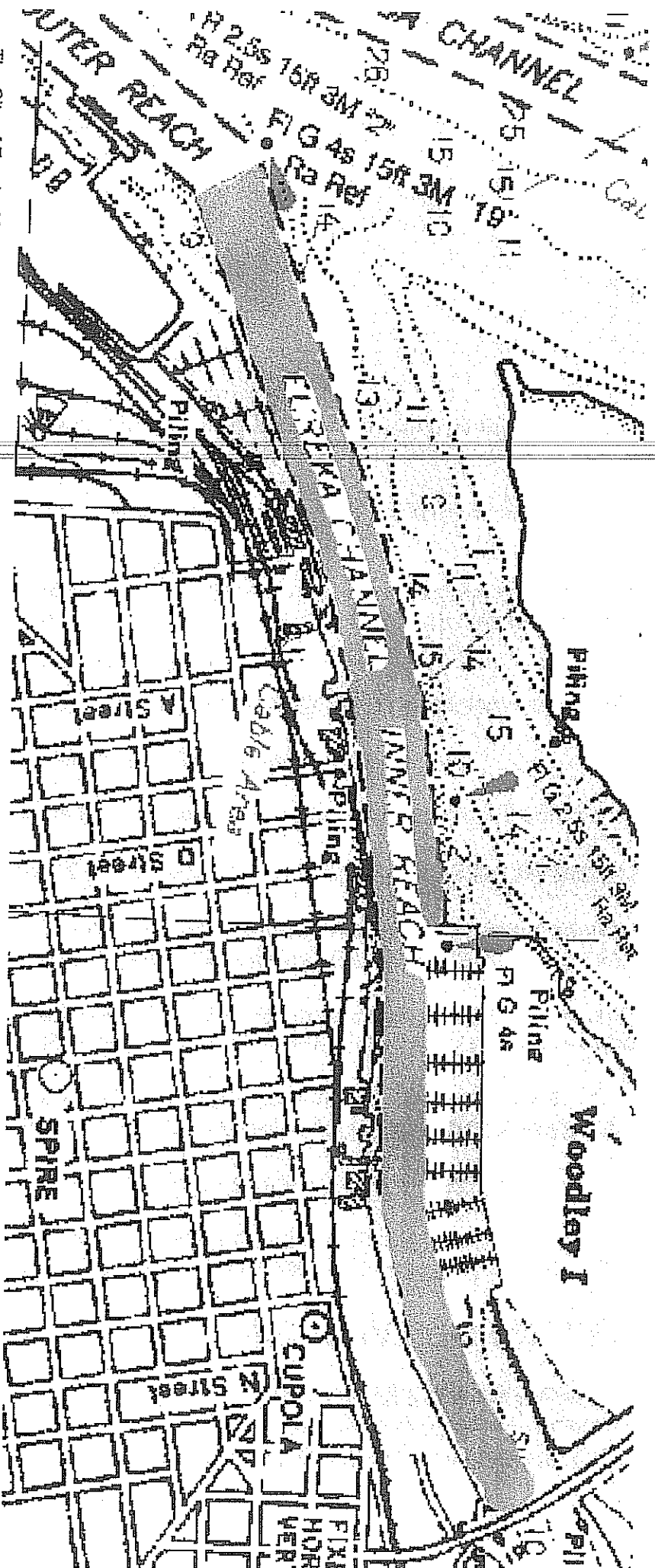
Use **EXTREME CAUTION** around the two **FUEL FACILITIES** on Humboldt Bay – **ENGLUND MARINE** and the **CHEVRON MARINE TERMINAL** – watch your wake.
 3. **THERE IS A SECURITY ZONE AROUND THE FUEL BARGE - PLEASE GIVE THEM THE RIGHT OF WAY.** Tug Koos King and the USCG will escort the barge.
 4. **A CHIP/LOG BARGE MAY ARRIVE – PLEASE GIVE THEM THE RIGHT OF WAY.**
 5. You must have a personal flotation device for each person on board your vessel.
 6. You must carry visual distress signals when in the ocean.
 7. **NO PERSON SHALL OPERATE A VESSEL WITH A BLOOD ALCOHOL LEVEL OF 0.08 OR HIGHER.** *.04 CHARTER BOAT*
 8. If you plan on anchoring in Humboldt Bay longer than 72 hours, you must obtain an **ANCHORING PERMIT** from the HUMBOLDT BAY HARBOR DISTRICT on Woodley Island 707-443-0801. Permit is free.
 9. **BUOY 2 HAS BEEN MOVED - PLEASE NOTE ITS CURRENT LOCATION.**

The City of Eureka Municipal Code Section 100.14

(B) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a vessel at a speed that generates a noticeable wake within the Eureka Inner Reach Channel, defined as that waterway along the Eureka mainland between the southern section of the Samoa Bridge and the westernmost extension of Eureka's Small Boat Basin.

Section 100.99 PENALTY. Whoever violates any provision of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000. Each day any person is in violation shall constitute a separate offense punishable as provided herein. ('63 Code, § 11-1.601) (Ord. 336-C.S., passed 3-18-81)
